

Constitution

Article I – Name

The name of the society is “Nechako Valley Exhibition”, hereafter referred to as the Society.

Article II – Purposes

The purposes of the Society are:

1. To promote and encourage the development of farming and livestock industries in the northern interior.
2. To increase public awareness of the region’s agricultural potential through the hosting of an annual fall fair, and to provide a venue for displaying products and talents in friendly competition.
3. To maintain the fair grounds and facilities in good condition and to make same available to any person(s) who wish(es) to use the grounds and/or facilities in accordance with the Society’s objectives. This includes but is not limited to the dedication of the grounds and facilities of the Nechako Valley Exhibition Society for the purposes of the annual fall fair and the continuous operation of the riding arena for equestrian, livestock related activities, and other community events. The charge for using the facility and grounds will be as agreed upon by the Society from time to time. Such charges will reflect market value and will not be used as a method to dissuade groups from renting the facilities.
4. To provide residents an opportunity to associate with and learn from others in the agricultural field and thereby positively contribute to the standard of products and livestock produced in the northern interior.

Article III – Area of Operation

1. The operation of the Society will be carried on chiefly in the Nechako Valley and District in the Province of British Columbia.

Article IV – Dissolution

1. In the event of dissolution of the Society, any assets remaining after payment of all debts and obligations will revert to the Regional District of Bulkley Nechako. This provision with reference to dissolution is unalterable.
